October 2nd & 3rd 2010

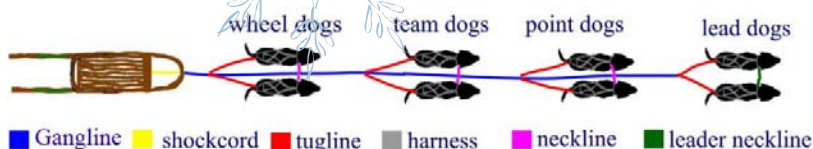
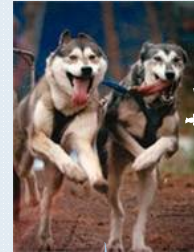
This event will be run on Saturday as a training day with the option to run your dogs any time between 7.00 am and 4.00 pm,

From the north: Leave M74 @ Gretna and follow the A6071 for Longtown come into Longtown over bridge and take first left turning just past garage where Spar shop is signposted Penton. ALL: continue along road approx 5 miles and arrive at t-junction. At Bridge Inn pub turn right and continue along road going through Catlowdy and approx 2 mile past Catlowdy you will arrive at race site on left hand side of road
